131/12 Apologies

There were apologies for absence from Councillor Simon Taylor (ill).

132/12 Variations in Order of Business

There were no variations in the Order of Business.

133/12 Declaration of Members' Interests

No Councillor declared an interest.

134/12 Public Speaking

1. District Councillor Jean Monks gave a brief update on the new refuse collection service and checked if anyone had received any reports of issues (no one had).
2. PC Ian Richardson reported that incidents of car break-ins in remote locations had reduced in recent months. The main issue for police at present was break-ins to communal garages in the Hope Valley, but this wasn't seen as an issue for Hathersage because it didn't have any of these.

135/12 Minutes of Parish Council Meeting

It was resolved to confirm as a correct record minutes of the meeting held on 26 September 2012.

136/12 Footpaths

1. The Clerk explained the updates that he and Councillor Bill Gordon had made to the Council's previous submission to PDNPA regarding the public consultation on the proposed permanent Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) on Long Causeway. It was resolved that the Clerk should submit this updated version to PDNPA.
2. Councillor Bill Hanley suggested that a good permanent commemoration of the Queen's Diamond Jubilee in the village might be to designate a new footpath and call it the "Jubilee Footpath" or something similar. After discussion, two possible footpaths were suggested:
  - a. A continuation of the permissive path that currently runs up the Ridgeway, avoiding the road. At the moment it diverts down to Hurstrclough Lane, but it was suggested that the path be extended to join Out Lane.
  - b. Using a track that runs above The Dale, to make a footpath that started near Mitchell's Field and ended near the junction of Main Road and School Lane. This route had been used for junior fell races in the past.

It was resolved that these suggestions be taken to a meeting being held in the village the following night, to discuss permanent commemorations of the Jubilee. The Clerk and the Chairman planned to attend this meeting and agreed to suggest these ideas.

137/12 Finance

1. It was resolved to note the Statement of Accounts as at 28 September 2012.
2. It was resolved to authorise the following accounts for payment (total sum £707.62):

138/12 Derbyshire County Council Snow Warden Scheme

It was suggested that a second Snow Warden be appointed for the Parish, to cover times when the Clerk was absent. Councillor Bill Hanley agreed to take on this role. The Clerk would meet with Councillor Hanley to explain what was required.

139/12 Consultations

It was resolved that Council did not wish to comment on PDNPA's Consultation on Issues and Preferred Approaches for Development Management Policies.

#### 140/12 Correspondence for Decision

1. The Clerk reported that he had received an email that morning saying that all places on the meeting on Public Rights of Way at Derbyshire Eco Centre had been filled. A number of Councillors said they had an interest in attending the meeting if it was repeated.

#### 141/12 Felling Licence Application – North Lees Woods

A letter from PDNPA regarding this matter had been received after the meeting agenda had been published. A response was required well before the next Council meeting. Therefore, this was added as an emergency item. It was resolved that the Council had no objection to this felling licence.

#### 143/12 Committee Reports

1. Hathersage Parish Council (HPC) – Councillor Marsden gave a report of the last meeting of HPC. It was resolved that Councillor Claxton would attend the meeting of HPC on 6/11/12.
2. Recreation Committee – Councillor Whitney reported that the Committee was now called the “Swimming Pool Committee”. The Clerk asked if there were any details of the new Leisure Committee, but these were not available yet. Councillor Whitney reported the excellent work being done by the new Marketing Group for the Pool, including updates to the new pool brochure.
3. Joint Transport Committee – It was reported that the JTC had discussed numerous parking issues in the village, along with possible solutions, and that these matters were now being taken forward with the appropriate authorities. The issues relating to the “pinch point” on Main Road near the Chemist had also been discussed.
4. Heart for Hathersage – Councillor Whitney reported that the plans for the new village centre could now be found on the PDNPA planning website.
5. Lafarge Liaison Committee – Councillor Claxton asked for the minutes of the latest meeting to be added to the Correspondence File. This was done.
6. Stanage Forum – Councillor Hodgkinson reported that the new constitution for the Stanage Forum was now prepared, so a first meeting of the new Forum would be arranged soon.

#### 144/12 Parish Matters and Items for Next Agenda

1. Possible locations in the village for the proposed plaque commemorating George Lawrence were discussed. It was resolved that the best location was the Swimming Pool, as this was the building in the village most associated with George Lawrence. The Clerk was asked to write to Brian Ward about this.
2. Councillor Hanley noted that the tarpaulin on Gamekeepers Cottage had still not been replaced. It was resolved that the Clerk would write to PDNPA about this.
