- 15 **Mythem Bridge and roadworks:** following damage to the road undercut by the river measures currently in place are single-way, light-controlled traffic. It is understood repairs are planned in the winter when the road will be closed with likely diversions through Hathersage; to consider the impact and any Parish Council response
- 16 **Hope Valley Rail Capacity Scheme:** any updates from VolkerRailStory and to note changes to timetables and station closures (details previously circulated) to accommodate work.
